# CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

## DESCRIPTION

The XVIIIth edition of the Summer School on "The Protection of Fundamental Rights in Europe" aims to provide undergraduate students, practitioners, civil servants and young researchers (Ph.D. candidates – Post docs) with an understanding of the role played by fundamental rights at national, European and international level. This year, the Summer School will focus on the the interaction between different levels of protection of fundamental rights in Europe. This implies, essentially, recent developments on the European Convention of Human Rights and the European Union systems of protection of fundamental rights and shortcomings on the protection of fundamental rights at national level (i.e. by Constitutional Courts). The course will consist in 30 hours of lectures and/or seminars held in **English or French (the working languages)**, which will take place from 09:30-13:00 and 15:00-16:30 each day (Monday - Friday). The Summer School places a particular emphasis on the interaction between professors and students, who are expected to demonstrate, during the lectures, a strong interest and a general knowledge of the topics. Students are encouraged in actively participating in the courses.

## ADMISSION AND FEES

Participants are selected on a first to come first to serve basis, provided that they have a sufficient knowledge of the working languages (English and French), until expiry of available places (in this case, priority will be given to students of the University of Bologna and to Ph.D. candidates). Selected participants will have **complimentary 5-nights half-board accommodation** (lunch and breakfast) at the University Centre of Bertinoro ([www.ceub.it](http://www.ceub.it)), thanks to the support provided by the **Fondazione Cassa dei Risparmi di Forlì**, plus the possibility to attend the course **without having to pay subscription fees**. Applicants are requested to send via email their CV (please clearly state name/ surname, residence and date of birth, phone number) and certificates (or self-certification) attesting experiences abroad and knowledge of languages (all documents merged in a **single PDF file**). Please be aware that the email and the attachment constitutes your application form. Please be aware that we are unable to assist, for those in need, with VISA arrangements. Selected students will be contacted by the 15th of June 2018.
